Dear Parents/Carer,

We are pleased to have welcomed all our pupils back to Hurst Hill this week.

Our whole school risk assessment is working well and we are happy with the return to school. As a result of feedback from staff and parents, and because of scaffolding on site, we will be changing the collection of pupils at the end of the school day from **Monday 7**th **September.** There will be NO change to the start of the day procedures which will remain as a staggered start with drop off between 8.30-8.55am. Do <u>not</u> arrive on site before 8.30am.


We will move to a staggered collection of between 3-3.15pm for pupils with the exception of Mrs Fryer's and Miss Abley's class. This means you can collect your child anytime between 3 o'clock and 3.15pm. Please do not arrive earlier than 3pm as this causes congestion. Last collection is 3.15pm though so please do not be late as the same penalties apply for late collection. Please stay 2m apart from other adults and you can wear a face mask if you prefer.

Mrs Fryer's class need to be collected at exactly 3pm from the exit opposite the school hall. Please note, this is a change to their collection point to ease congestion. There is no change to their drop off point which will still be the Y3/4 cloakroom door.

Miss Abley's class need to be collected at exactly 3.15pm from their classroom door. Please do not arrive early. Pupils with siblings in school will be lined up ready to exit first, to prevent parents having to gather on the playground for too long.

Thank you to all parents for your co-operation as we know it is challenging for everyone. We really appreciate the parent support that we have received.
