### The Bible


This is the Christian Holy Book. It is divided into the Old Testament which is before Jesus and the New Testament which is about Jesus' life and teachings.



# Believing


### The Holy Trinity



# **God's Guidance**


### The Qur'an

The word Qur'an means 'the recitation'. This is a collection of messages as they were given to Muhammed by Allah.

Often Muslims perform wudu, a ritual washing of the face, hands and feet before reading it and it is kept closed and wrapped in cloth when it is not being used. There are 114 chapters divided into 30 parts, so they often recite one part each day to read the whole Qur'an in one month.
