We should be able to recognise that a range of technology is used in places such as homes and schools. We should select and use technology for particular purposes.

Key Skills

Logging on the computer, using a password, changing my password if I need to.	Children will be able to input the correct information into the log in section of a website. To assist they can be provided with a template which has their username and password on it. Make sure that this is kept secure within the class. It works well when you make it clear to the children that they need to add capitals when required. Key questions: How do you log in? Why do you need to keep log in information safe? What happens if I continue to type in a password incorrectly?
Logging on to RM unify.	Children will be able to log on to RM unify and investigate the different tiles and games. Children will log on to purple mash and look at where the 2Dos are set. How will they access a tile? How will they find work set by the teacher?
To save work with a file name and print work	Children will be able to open 2 paint and create a picture. Children will be able to save their work with a file name. Can they give it a name they will remember?
To find and open a file to work on it again.	Can the children remember how to open their file? The children will be able to reopen their file and carry on working on it. Re-save their work so they can find it again.
To draw a picture, changing the colour and size of the pen.	Children will be taught to manipulate the objects on screen using the tools in purple mash. Can they change colours and pen sizes?
To write a sentence using the keyboard.	As this is a crucial part of being able to access the computer the children will need to be able to know how to type. To help this the children will need to be familiar with finding the capital letters. To aid this it is advised that you provide the children with a resource that has the capital letter and the lower case to aid this. Explore the use of the shift key for single letters being typed in caps and the caps lock. Take the time to discuss where we could use these different features. The space bar is integral. Children should be encouraged to explore the keyboard to see what it does.
