Pulse	The heart beat of the music
Rhythm	Different long and short sounds which make a pattern
Pitch	Low and high notes
Improvise	Use the notes for the song in a different way.

Melody	Notes put together to make a piece of music.
Chorus	A repeating phrase in song.
Verse	A section of the song which has the same tune but different words.
Introduction	The start of the song before we sing.



Key Skills and knowledge

Listen and Appraise —Can I learn how they can enjoy moving to music by dancing, marching, being animals or pop stars?

Musical games — Can I find the pulse?

Can I copy back short rhythmic phrases based on words, with one and two syllables whilst marching the steady beat? $\frac{1}{2}$


