Light is a positive symbol for Jews, representing:

The shabbat candles are lit every Friday evening to see in the Sabbath day. This ritual is usually performed by a woman and she moves her hands over the candle and towards her as though bringing in the Sabbath. Shen then covers her eyes and recites a blessing.

Hanukkah

This is the Jewish festival of light. It is celebrated for 8 days in November or December.



The Menorah is lit during the festival from right to left, one is lit each day.

During Hanukkah Jews follow simple religious rituals in addition to their daily prayers form the Siddur.
