Il est midi/minuit – It is noon.

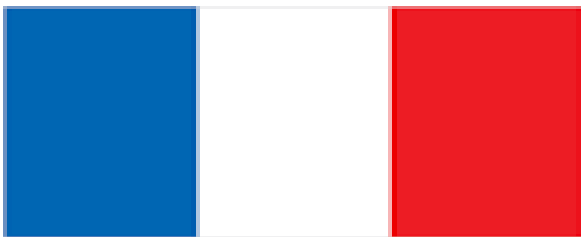
Brothers and sisters.
