# Religious Education in the Foundation Stage-Reception







### What does it look like?

Children in Reception learn about how we are all different and that we have different likes and dislikes. In finding out about others, children start reflecting on the beliefs and cultures. They will begin to explore how other people have different beliefs and will learn about traditions such as Diwali. Eid and Chinese New Year. They will learn about Christianity and some of the key celebrations, such as, Christmas and Easter. Experiences will be captured through stories, photos. toys, role-play, dance, art and design and conversations children have with peers and adults. These early experiences provide the foundations for more formal teaching of RE in preparation for when they move to year one. The children's learning is guided through their interests, individual needs and stages of

- Understand that not everyone shares the same beliefs and that is okay.
- Explore first-hand some of the experiences that take place during festivals. Such as, dancing, food tasting, singing and creating art work.
