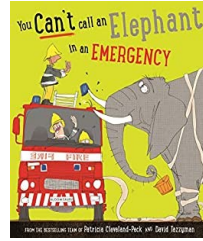
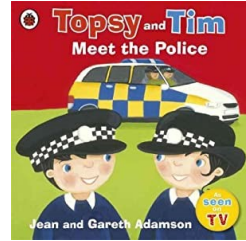
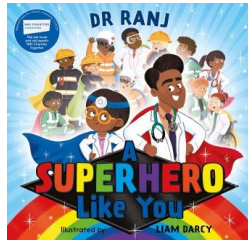

A healthy lifestyle is a way of living that lowers the risk of being ill or becoming seriously ill



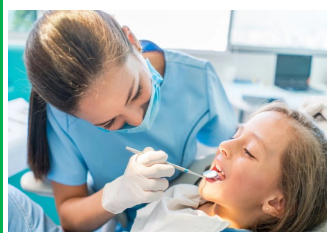
**Superhero —**
