Dear Parents/Carers,

We have previously sent an expression of interest form regarding a residential trip to The Pioneer Centre, Shropshire from 4th June 2025 to 6th June 2025. This is a fantastic way to celebrate the end of your child's year 6 learning journey and the hard work that I have no doubt they will put into their studies. Based on the responses from the expression of interest form, we are asking for a non-refundable £30 deposit to be paid via Parent Mail by 1st March 2024 to secure our booking.

The Pioneer Centre gives an exciting opportunity for your child to spend 2 nights and 3 days away from home, which will be filled with outdoor adventurous activities, such as: high ropes, abseiling, raft building, caving, low ropes, zip wiring archery and much more.

The maximum cost of the trip will be £285. However, this is the maximum price of the trip and may be reduced once we have confirmed the final number of children wanting to attend. This price includes all transportation, activities with fully trained group leaders from 9am until 8pm each day, 3 cooked meals per day and overnight accommodation for the duration of the trip.

Payment plans designed to help spread the cost of the remaining balance can be organised with the office team, please speak Mrs. Pilbeam if you would like further information.

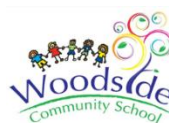
