



Dear Parent/Carer

Children have settled well back into school and we would like to remind you of our expectations for homework.

Please ensure that your child brings their book bag everyday, with their reading book and planner inside. Children should read for at least 10 minutes at home every evening and we ask that this is noted in their planner. Reading books are changed on a weekly basis. Children can read a book on MyOn instead but please still write in your child's planner.

Homework will be set on Fridays, as per our homework policy, which is available to read on our website. Homework should be completed and returned by the following Wednesday.

**Children in reception class** will have paper copies of homework sent every Friday, along with a new reading book. Parents are asked to upload photographs of home events regularly to their child's Tapestry account to keep us up to date with any learning at home.

**KS1 children** will use Purple Mash for their homework. This can be accessed via the RM Unify link on our website. When they have finished their tasks, they send it to their teacher by pressing the hand in button.

From next week, **all children in KS2** will use Google Classroom for their homework. Once completed, they are able to turn in their homework online, or alternatively take a photograph of written work and upload.

Children's effort and achievements with homework are rewarded and praised. Teachers will mark homework weekly and keep records of children completing homework. These records will be checked on a regular basis.
