Update to COVID guidance

Following the recent changes to the COVID advice from the government, please find an update below.

Children should not come to school if they have any of the main symptoms of COVID (new, continuous cough, or a high temperature, or a loss of, or change in, their normal sense of taste or smell). You should then arrange for your child to take a PCR test. If the PCR test is positive, then they should remain at home for a minimum of 5 full days and then continue to follow guidance until they have received 2 negative LFT test results on consecutive days. Test results should be sent to info@hurst-hill.dudley.sch.uk

If children develop symptoms at school, parents/carers will be asked to collect and arrange a PCR test

There is no longer a requirement for contacts of positive cases to take daily LFTs, and twice weekly testing is no longer necessary.
