I am writing to inform you that as part of our science lessons, we will soon be introducing class caterpillars to the classroom. This is to provide an opportunity for our students to learn about the transformation of insects as part of our curriculum.

We understand that some of our students may have allergies and we want to ensure that we take all necessary precautions to safeguard their health. If your child has an allergy to caterpillars or any other insects, please inform us by Friday 16th June. This will give us enough time to make necessary arrangements. As always, we take the health and safety of our students very seriously. We will ensure that appropriate measures are taken to minimize the risk of any adverse reactions or allergies.

The caterpillars are in a sealed container and at no point will the children be handling them. We also encourage parents/carers to discuss the observation of caterpillars with their children at home, so that they can safely observe the physical transformation of the caterpillars into butterflies. It is recommended not to touch any caterpillars found outside in case they cause a reaction.
