Dear Parents/Carers,

As a fantastic way to celebrate the end of your child's year 6 learning journey and the hard work, that I have no doubt they will have put into their studies this year, we are planning a residential trip to Kingswood, Staffordshire. The trip will take place from **Wednesday 19th June to Friday 21st June 2024.** It is an exciting opportunity for your child to spend 2 nights and 3 days away from home, which will be filled with outdoor adventurous activities, such as: high ropes, abseiling, raft building, caving, low ropes, zip wiring archery and much more.

The maximum cost of the trip will be £295. However, this is the maximum price of the trip and may be reduced once we have confirmed the final number of children wanting to attend. If we do not have enough interest then we will be unable to proceed with this visit. This price includes all transportation, activities with fully trained group leaders from 9am until 8pm each day, 3 cooked meals per day and overnight accommodation for the duration of the trip.

If you would like to confirm a place for your child to attend, we are asking for a **£75 deposit to be** paid via Parent Mail by 18th September 2023. The remaining balance will then be required in the following instalments:

- £75 by 6th November 2023
- £100 by 1st March 2024
- £45 by 1st May 2024

Please note that payments are non-refundable and you will be charged should your child decide they no longer wish to go.

As a school, we will be monitoring behaviour closely throughout the year and will only take pupils who have consistently demonstrated that they can adhere to the Hurst Hill values and school rules.
