



Dear Parents/Carers

Sports day and Transition meetings

For the past two years, our sports day has been on the school playgrounds. This decision was made due to safeguarding concerns raised from previous events on the field. Some parents were not remaining behind the crowd control markings and this caused anxiety for some children and their carers.

Last year, many parents expressed their views and requested for it to be held on the field again. I have listened to this and if weather permits – and providing all parents can follow the safeguarding procedures - we shall hold this year's KS1 and KS2 Sports Day on the field. The planned date for this is Friday 7th July.

To ensure the safeguarding of our children all parents/carers must remain behind the crowd control tape that will be set up. Teachers will be responsible for children throughout the day so parents will not be allowed to cross over the field to their children. Parents who disregard the safety arrangements that are in place to protect our children will be asked to leave or the event may be cancelled, and further events will not be held on the field.

There will not be any chairs for spectators so please feel free to bring your own chairs or picnic blankets. There will be no access to toilets. The PTA will be selling hot drinks for parents only. Children will have their own water bottles with them.

Transition meetings

The transition meetings give the opportunity for parents to receive information regarding the arrangements for their child's new September class. Following the meeting, parents will be asked to leave school premises to join the sports day on the field. In the event of the weather being inclement, the transition meetings will still go ahead as planned.

KS2 – 9.45am – At 9am parents are invited to the transition meeting that will be held in the school hall.

KS1 – 1.45pm – At 1pm parents are invited to the transition meeting that will be held in the school hall.

Parents who do not attend the transition meetings, should access the field using the entrance on Quilter Close.
